## Job Summary

The County Extension Director provides administrative leadership for all aspects of the County Extension program operations including: personnel management, staff development, affirmative action, civil rights, fiscal management, budget development, facilities and equipment, technology, marketing, and public relations.

Facilitate efforts of his/her staff regarding county program planning, implementation and evaluation.

The County Extension Director roll is in addition to limited program duty responsibilities.

The County Extension Director is administratively accountable to the District Extension Director for all assigned administrative and supervisory matters in the county.

Travel within assigned county and district is required including occasional overnight travel. Travel budget is provided.

Continuation of this position is subject to the need for the position, performance, and availability of federal and state funds.

#### **Qualifications**

A master's degree with at least one degree in Agriculture, Family and Consumer Sciences, or in an area related to Extension education.

Five or more years in Cooperative Extension or closely related work are required.

Prior successful work experiences utilizing personnel and fiscal management, and supervision is required. Leadership roles and interaction with governmental and public agency officials is desirable.

Excellent oral and written communication skills.

Visionary team leadership skills are essential.
